WHAT IS SALT?



Reading, quiz practice, and club competitions will be done through the school club in preparation for an area-wide tournament against other SALT teams from area schools.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE CLUB?

ANY 3RD-6TH GRADE STUDENT WITH TEACHER APPROVAL CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE SALT CLUB.

Students compete on teams in one of two grade level divisions: 3rd-4th or 5th-6th. A team's division is determined by the oldest participant on the team.

WHAT BOOKS DO WE READ AND QUIZ ON?

STUDENTS WILL BE QUIZZED USING QUESTIONS COMPILED FROM CONTENT IN THE BOOKS FOUND ON THE SALT READING LIST WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT SALTVAULT.ORG.

The 3rd-4th Grade Division will quiz over 12 books and 5th-6th will quiz over 16 books. Reading selections include family-friendly books from the following genres: Adventure, Mystery, Classics, Historical Fiction, Bible, Fantasy, and Non-fiction.

WHEN AND WHERE DO WE PARTICIPATE?

STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE SCHOOL SALT CLUB FOR QUIZ PRACTICES AND CLUB COMPETITIONS. CLUB TEAMS PARTICIPATE IN AN AREA-WIDE TOURNAMENT HOSTED BY SALEM ACADEMY IN THE SPRING.

Dates, times, and locations for team practices and competions against each other are determined by the SALT coach or club administrator. The area-wide tournament will be held at Salem Academy where opening ceremonies start the day, with the quizzing competition immediately following.
